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Structural Engineers, **DM Berg Consultants, P.C.**, reports on 3 projects:

“Area D-4 Station Redevelopment” in South Boston consists of the redevelopment of the 30,000 square foot former police station consisting of a four-story brick building which was completed in 1932 and sits on a 13,072 square foot lot with an underground parking garage. The redevelopment will provide luxury condominiums for the South End area. The Architectural Team, Inc. is implementing French architect Phillipe Starck’s design.

“Harrison Commons” in Boston with Bruner/Cott & Associates, Inc. consists of renovating the former five-story Boston College High school to create interior space to be used for luxury loft condominiums while maintaining the exterior façade and roof of the building for historic preservation concerns.

“Lawrence Mills” in Lowell with The Architectural Team, Inc. consists of an extensive renovation of Buildings 8 and 9 into condominiums and rehabilitation of Buildings 16, 17, and 18 into artist lofts and gallery space. The original buildings are of mill-type wood post and beam construction with exterior brick masonry bearing walls.

Additional projects DM Berg is working on are “Cambridge Vineyard Christian Fellowship Church” and “Beacon Hill Residences” both with CBT Architects and “Charleston Lofts” in Chelsea with Neshamkin French Architects, Inc.
