PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Renovation and expansion of the town's existing main library which was originally constructed in 1912. The renovation and expansion was necessary to accommodate the needs of the town's residents and today's technology.

A new composite steel framed structure was mated to the existing masonry, wood, and steel construction. The new structure was "inserted" into the demolished stack wing of the existing building. The two buildings were connected at this junction to provide lateral force resistance to the existing structure via load transfer to new steel ordinary moment frames.
